THE CITY OF CHELSEA HAS CREATED A VOLUNTARY SPECIAL NEEDS REGISTRY TO IDENTIFY RESIDENTS WHO MIGHT NEED EXTRA ASSISTANCE DURING A MAJOR EMERGENCY.

...such as a mass evacuation, a public health emergency like a pandemic, or an independent emergency like a health crisis or a fire in your home.

This registry is for residents with disabilities, chronic conditions, and/or special healthcare needs who live at home. This registry is not for individuals in a care facility such as a hospital, nursing home or assisted living facility.

Signing up for this registry will help the city's emergency management officials plan, prepare for, and respond to the needs of the community in the event of an emergency. Remember, the first line of defense against disaster is personal preparedness. Participation in the registry does not guarantee any special rights or privileges.

Your information will be kept secure and only used for emergency preparedness or response.

Use life support systems, like oxygen or a ventilator



Have trouble walking or rely on a wheelchair or a walker to get around
