



VITA Volunteer Role Description

Looking for a way to help in your community? For over 50 years people like you have provided free tax preparation in their community. VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) offers free tax help to people with low-to-moderate incomes, seniors, persons with disabilities, those with limited English proficiency and others who need help preparing their taxes. With many people experiencing financial changes this year, additional volunteers are needed to provide free income tax assistance. This volunteer opportunity is remote.

No prior certifications are required, but due to the needs of our community, we prefer (but do not require) VITA volunteers to be bilingual in English, and preferably, Spanish. All VITA training will be provided.

Time Commitment: **Mid-January to April 15th. Flexible hours.**

CORI (background) Check: **Required**

Language Requirement: We are currently seeking **bilingual** English and Spanish speakers - must be **FLUENT** in both. (We can accept a few English-only speakers, but bilingual volunteers are the priority)
